

Special Provisions NNM16AA01C

The following special terms, conditions, and/or clauses apply when the subject prime contract number is indicated on the purchase order provided to the supplier of goods or services and considered in addition to the All Points Standard Terms and Conditions, F-AQ-015.

NASA Far Supplement 1852.211-70 – Packaging, Handling, and Transportation (Sep 2005) – Applies to all orders for components of deliverable Class I, II, or III items.

Material Inspection and Receiving Report (1852.246-72) (Aug 2003)

- (a) At the time of each delivery to the Government under this order, the Supplier/Vendor shall furnish a Material Inspection and Receiving Report (DD Form 250 series) prepared in three (3) copies, an original and two (2) copies.
- (b) The Supplier/Vendor shall prepare the DD Form 250 in accordance with NASA Far Supplement 1846.6. The Supplier/Vendor shall enclose the copies of the DD Form 250 in the package or seal them in a waterproof envelope, which shall be securely attached to the exterior of the package in the most protected location.
- (c) When more than one package is involved in a shipment, the Supplier/Vendor shall list on the DD Form 250, as additional information, the quantity of packages and the package numbers. The Supplier/Vendor shall forward the DD Form 250 with the lowest numbered package of the shipment and print the words “CONTAINS DD FORM 250” on the package.

Free on Board (F.o.B.) Point

- (a) The F.o.B. point for deliverables shall be the George C. Marshall Space Flight Center (MSFC), Marshall Space Flight Center, AL 35812 or the Michoud Assembly Facility (MAF), New Orleans, LA 70129, at the sites requiring the deliverables, or for specific items, when so directed, at an authorized different location.
- (b) Those items having the F.o.B. point at a facility other than MSFC or MAF, shall be shipped as directed by All Points in accordance with clause 52.247-1, Commercial Bill of Lading Notations.

H.13 HAZARDOUS MATERIAL REPORTING (MSFC 52.223-91)(FEB 2016)

(a) If during the performance of this contract, the Contractor transports or accepts delivery of any hazardous materials (hazardous as defined under the latest version of Federal Standard No. 313, including revisions adopted during the term of the contract) on-site to Marshall Space Flight Center, the hazardous material shall be processed through MSFC Central Receiving to be bar-coded for inventory. Alternative receiving points may be designated if approval is granted in accordance with MWI 8550.5, *Hazardous Material Management*. Chemical containers shall be managed in accordance with the provisions of MWI 8550.5. The Contractor shall be responsible for ensuring that all Contractor/subcontractor personnel are made aware of and comply with this clause.

(b) Nothing contained in this clause shall relieve the Contractor from complying with applicable Federal, State, and local laws, codes, ordinances, and regulations (including the obtaining of licenses and permits) in connection with hazardous material; or with clauses regarding hazardous materials, which may be contained in the contract and/or order.
